Construction Vocational Cantonese Course

Course Code: CVCZ

Hong Kong Institute of Construction (HKIC) offers a Construction Industry Vocational Cantonese Course to help ethnic minorities communicate in simple Cantonese in the construction work environment or daily life. We aim to attract more ethnic minorities to join the construction industry and receive relevant training.

This course is suitable for the ethnic minorities who are planning to work or currently working in the construction industry.

Course Content

- Cantonese pronunciation;
- Listening and recognition skills;
- Construction terms;

- Occupational safety terms;
- Words in date and time;
- Conversation in workplace, restaurant, traveling, shopping and bargaining, socialising with friends and colleagues, visiting clinic or hospital, banking, job interview; and other vocabularies

Duration

20 sessions (60 hours) 3 sessions per week, 3 hours per session

HK\$500 (refundable upon award of certificate)

Skills Enhancement Courses for Ethnic Minorities

Hong Kong Institute of Construction (HKIC) offers a series of Skills Enhancement Courses in order to train up ethnic minorities who are Registered General Workers to become Intermediate Tradesman (Semi-skilled Workers). General Workers can then be employed as Intermediate Tradesman (Registered Semi-skilled Workers) of the related trade division and can independently carry out construction works of the specified trade division on construction sites to meet the requirements of "designated works" under the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance. A bonus will be awarded to those who comply with the requirements and obtain the designated Intermediate Trade Test Qualification.

Weekend Class:

An attendance rate of 85% or above is required. Students who meet the minimum attendance requirement will be recommended by HKIC to take the Intermediate Trade Test. In order to be entitled to the bonus of HK\$4,000, these students are required to pass the Intermediate Trade Test recommended by HKIC within 3 months after the completion of the course (a maximum of 2 fee waivers).

Weekday Class:

An attendance rate of 85% or above is required. Students will receive a bonus of \$4,000 upon achieving the attendance requirement and will be recommended by HKIC to take the Intermediate Trade Test. Students who have passed the Intermediate Trade Test will be recommended by HKIC within 3 months after the completion of the

course (a maximum of 2 fee waivers) will receive an additional bonus of \$10,000

(If applicant violates any course requirements before admission and intermediate trade test, the study will be terminated without prior notice and no bonus will be entitled.)

Admission Requirements

- Ethnic minorities in Hong Kong
- Card holder of Registered General Worker (RGW) or Registered Semi-Skilled Worker or holder of Intermediate Trade Test qualification (non-applied trade)
- At least 1 year of working experience in the relevant trade
- Applicants for General Welding course (M02Z / M52N) must be a certificate holder of Gas Welding Safety Training Course
- Applicants can only apply for one course at a time. Applicants can apply for another course 12 months after the completion of the first course
- Applicants cannot be existing trainees / students of any courses offered by the Construction Industry Council or the Hong Kong Institute of Construction
- Applicants cannot be the holder of Registered Skilled Worker Card or any trade test qualification
