## ELIGIBILITY

1. Eligible employees in Hong Kong (i.e. persons legally residing in Hong Kong who are free to be employed or work without conditions, including Hong Kong permanent residents and new arrivals); and
2. Registered general workers; and
3. At least 1 year relevant working experience (verified by the training bodies); and
4. For those who have not registered as registered semi-skilled workers or registered skilled workers of any trade under Construction Workers Registration Ordinance; and
5. Has not obtained the intermediate trade test certificate or trade test certificate qualification; and
6. Has not taken the courses offered or funded by the CIC and HKIC over one year prior to application.
